

DIRECTIONS TO: Erie County Commission Chambers

FROM THE EAST (Cleveland):

Take **Route 2 West**, or **Ohio Turnpike West**. Exit at Route 250. (The Turnpike exit is approximately 5 miles further south on Route 250 than the Route 2 exit.) **Take Route 250 West**.

On the right you will pass a Wal-Mart, a Meijer and the Sandusky Mall. At the first intersection after Sandusky Mall (**Strub Road**), **turn left**. At the next light, **turn right onto Columbus**. You will pass a cemetery and the Fairgrounds on the right. The large stone building just past the Fairgrounds is the Services Center. Enter the building from the rear off the visitors' parking lot.

FROM THE WEST (Toledo):

Take **Route 2 East** or **Ohio Turnpike East**. Exit at Route 4. (The Turnpike exit is approximately 4 miles further south on Route 4 than the Route 2 exit.) **Take Route 4 North**.

At the first intersection north of Route 2 (**Strub Road**), **turn right**. At the second traffic light **turn left onto Columbus**. You will pass a cemetery and the Fairgrounds on the right. The large stone building just past the Fairgrounds is the Services Center. Enter the building from the rear off the visitors' parking lot.

FROM THE SOUTH (Columbus):

Take **I-71 North** to **Route 13 Exit** (Mansfield). Take Route 13 North through Mansfield and continue north. At Fitchville, Route 250 joins Route 13. Take **Route 250 West**. Continue through Norwalk. Stay on Route 250 when Route 13 splits off north of Milan.

Route 250 will pass under Route 2. On the right you will pass a Wal-Mart, a Meijer and the Sandusky Mall. At the first intersection after Sandusky Mall (**Strub Road**), **turn left**. At the next light, **turn right onto Columbus**. You will pass a cemetery and the Fairgrounds on the right. The large stone building just past the Fairgrounds is the Services Center. Enter the building from the rear off the visitors' parking lot.

Continue north on Columbus into downtown Sandusky. The Courthouse will be on your left. At the next block, the intersection of **Washington Row** and Columbus Avenue, is the Erie County Office Building. Parking garage is at rear of building.

FROM THE WEST (Toledo):

Take **Route 2 East** or **Ohio Turnpike East**. Exit at Route 4. (The Turnpike exit is approximately 4 miles further south on Route 4 than the Route 2 exit.) **Take Route 4 North** to the intersection of Columbus Avenue.

Bear left onto Columbus and continue north on Columbus into downtown Sandusky. The Courthouse will be on your left. At the next block, the intersection of Washington Row and Columbus, is the Erie County Office Building. Parking garage is at rear of building.

FROM THE SOUTH (Columbus):

Take **I-71 North** to **Route 13 Exit** (Mansfield). Take Route 13 North through Mansfield and continue north. At Fitchville, Route 250 joins Route 13. Take **Route 250 West**. Continue through Norwalk. Stay on Route 250 when Route 13 splits off north of Milan.

Route 250 will pass under Route 2. On the right you will pass a Wal-Mart, a Meijer and the Sandusky Mall. Continue to the intersection of Perkins Avenue and turn **left onto Perkins Avenue**. Continue to Columbus Avenue and **turn right onto Columbus**.
