



## Immigration and Resettlement

### General Indicators:

- Immigration status
- Language skills based on needs
- Cultural identity and knowledge of dominant culture

<b>Growth Levels</b>	<b>5 - Thriving</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ All family members have legal residency status and/or one or more adult family members are citizens</li> <li>■ At least one adult family member is fluent in English</li> <li>■ Moves easily between primary and dominant culture</li> </ul>
	<b>4 - Safe/Self-Sufficient</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Maintains primary culture and is knowledgeable about dominant culture</li> <li>■ All adult members have legal residency status</li> <li>■ Continuing to learn language</li> </ul>
	<b>3 - Stable</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Participates in primary culture activity and continues to learn about dominant culture</li> <li>■ One or more adult family members have legal residency status</li> <li>■ Enrolled in language classes</li> </ul>
<b>Risk Levels</b>	<b>2 - At-Risk/Vulnerable</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Adults do not have legal residency status and/or are in process of obtaining legal residence</li> <li>■ Minimal English language skills</li> <li>■ Has established some linkages with primary culture and some knowledge of dominant culture</li> </ul>
	<b>1 - In-Crisis</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Family member facing deportation or family member has been deported</li> <li>■ Insufficient language skills to meet basic needs</li> <li>■ Isolated from primary culture</li> <li>■ Very little or no knowledge of dominant culture</li> </ul>
