

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PERSONAL
PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION**

Resolution No. 09-01, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Erie County on January 5, 2009, authorized the disposal of unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property, including motor vehicles by Internet auction. This resolution is in accordance with O.R.C. Section 307.12 as amended by H.B. 226 of the 124th General Assembly.

All Internet auctions will be conducted on commercial auction sites.

All items being offered by auction on the Internet will be listed on the Erie County website (http://www.erie-county-ohio.net/finance/purchasing/bid_opening.php) and will include a link to the commercial web site hosting the auction. See detailed terms and conditions posted for each item listed at the commercial website.

All items will be listed for a minimum of ten (10) days.

All items will be sold "as is, where is" with Erie County making no guarantee as to the condition of said items, and with the purchaser being responsible for the removal of said items from the Erie County Facility.

The purchaser will be required to make payment in full within five (5) days following the close of the auction.

No property will be released until payment in full has been received by Erie County.

The right is reserved to reject any and all bids.
